We currently produce a small core range and brew seasonal and collaboration beers on a regular basis, packaged in both can and keg.

We are looking for a brewer to join our passionate team who has the desire to push for excellence and who wishes to influence the products, processes and development of Full Circle as we grow. The brewer will be expected to work with the brewery team to develop new recipes and will have the opportunity to brew their own recipes on our 100L pilot kit.
